LONGROOD ROAD EXPERIENCING TRAFFIC ISSUES

County Councillor Kam Kaur sorted out the traffic calming issues requested by residents on Bawnmore Road.

However, these issues are being experienced by residents on Longrood Road as well and causing problems with drivers speeding, especially around school times.

In the current climate, more parents are driving their children to school, which is exacerbating an existing problem and when cars are getting caught up with

MARK PAWSEY MP - A&E SURVEY

According to the House of Commons Library 83% of people living in the Rugby constituency live more than a 15-minute drive from an A&E department.

This is due to the downgrading of the A&E department at the Hospital of St Cross in the late 1990s.

Since being elected as the town's MP in 2010, Mark has been firm that as Rugby grows,

the case for the restoration of A&E at St Cross has grown too.
