According to the House of Commons Library 83% of people living in the Rugby constituency live more than a 15-minute drive from an A&E department.

This is due to the downgrading of the A&E department at the Hospital of St Cross in the late 1990s

A&E at St Cross has grown too.

BUS SERVICE TO NEW HOULTON SCHOOL

Jill has been actively working with officers at Warwickshire County Council regarding bus services to Houlton school.

Stagecoach and WCC have confirmed that the Number 1 service from Coton Park, Eden Park, Brownsover will have one extended service to Houlton School in the mornings and a return journey starting at Houlton School in the afternoons, stopping on Boughton Road, near Crowthorns.

If there are lots of children on this route. then a second duplicate service can be arranged for the school times.
