In recent years this park has had fencing to stop unauthorised encampments, and trees were planted by local school children with Rugby Borough Council, but as outdoor space has become more important,

we feel it is time this park had a refresh.

Cllr Carolyn Robbins is already working with officers to get the pavements repaired and improved in the park.

SNELLSDALE FOOTPATH ISSUES

A resident on Coton Park recently contacted the Residents' Association over concerns about vehicles on a footpath. The Association notified Jill and she was on the case immediately to solve this.

The footpath is between Snellsdale Road and the construction road. Cars and vans have been using this footpath as a rat-run, which is both illegal and highly dangerous.

Jill immediately spoke to officers at Warwickshire County Council and also spoke to Persimmon, whilst establishing who was responsible for the path. The path was adopted by WCC about 6 months

ago and WCC are arranging for bollards to be placed on this footpath to stop the vehicles. The police have also been notified to watch for any further issues.

MARK PAWSEY MP - A&E SURVEY

According to the House of Commons Library 83% of people living in the Rugby constituency live more than a 15-minute drive from an A&E department.

This is due to the downgrading of the A&E department at the Hospital of St Cross in the late 1990s.

Since being elected as the town's MP in 2010, Mark has

been firm that as Rugby grows, the case for the restoration of A&E at St Cross has grown too.

BUS SERVICES TO NEW HOULTON SCHOOL

Jill has been actively working with officers at Warwickshire County Council regarding bus services to Houlton Secondary School.

Stagecoach and WCC have confirmed that the Number 1 service from Coton Park, Eden Park and Brownsover will have one extended service go to Houlton School in the mornings and a return journey, starting at Houlton School in the afternoon.

If there are lots of children on this route, then a second duplicate service can be arranged for the school times.

Tickets need to be purchased from Stagecoach.
